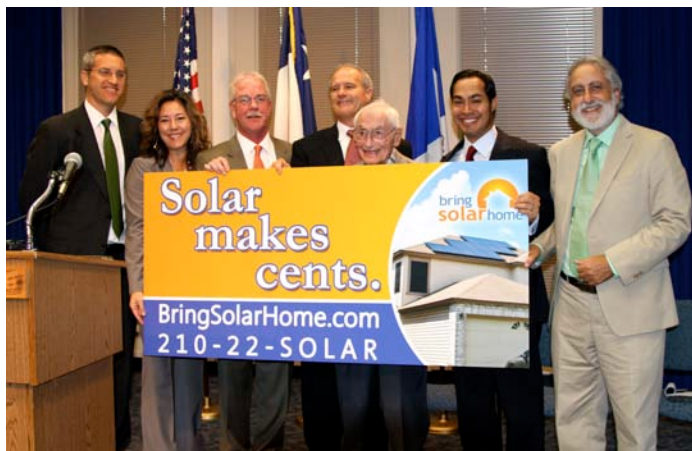

In September of 2010, the local non-profit organization launched the Bring Solar Home program to help homeowners install solar energy. By simplifying the process of "going solar," Solar San Antonio has contributed over 70 new solar installations in San Antonio in the past five months and anticipates continued success.
